53 Pastor Phill submitted a memo alerting elders that during the weekend of May 14/15, he
54 has invited high school youth from Word of Life (accompanied by adult leaders). They
55 will introduce themselves at the beginning of the service, and will be stationed at a table
56 in the narthex following the service. They will be going to California this summer for a
57 one-week mission trip (under LCMS auspices). Each student must raise \$465, so they
58 are doing car washes and other fund raising activities to pay for the trip. If any of our
59 members wish to help out, they will have this opportunity. Our Mission Board has voted
60 \$500 toward this endeavor. Pastor Phill mentioned that his larger purpose is to promote
61 some contact between the two parishes including, perhaps, pulpit sharing, a combined
62 men's retreat, etc.

63 Ron Pearson reminded elders that we are to complete cleanup of the altar before
64 leaving the altar area following communion (wine trays stacked and covered, wafer trays
65 covered, etc.)
